GRANT OF IN PRINCIPLE APPROVAL

Decision: The competent authority has granted 'in principle' approval for setting up of a **Rajkot International Greenfield Airport** for public use in Hirasar, District Rajkot, Gujarat subject to the following conditions and compliance of provisions of Airports Infrastructure Policy, 1997/guidelines for setting up of Greenfield airports in the country issued by Ministry of Civil Aviation from time to time.

Conditions of 'in principle' approval

- (i) Government of Gujarat will hand over the entire land to Airports Authority of India (AAI) free of cost.
- (ii) The State Government will allow and facilitate AAI to monetise/leverage the land of the existing Rajkot Airport to cover the capital and operational cost to be incurred in the new airport for increasing the financial viability of the project.
- (iii) Operations at existing AAI airport at Rajkot will cease, once the new Greenfield airport at Hirasar, Rajkot becomes operational.
- (iv) State Government shall fulfil all the conditions imposed by MoD, MoEF&CC, IMD, MHA, DGCA.
- (v) The development of the project should be in accordance with National Civil Aviation Policy (NCAP), 2016.
- (vi) The promoter shall be required to complete the necessary formalities with all the regulatory/Government agencies.
