(a): Ministry of Civil Aviation introduced seaplane operations from water aerodromes under the Regional Connectivity Scheme - Ude Desh Ka Aam Nagrik 3.0 (RCS-UDAN 3.0). During various rounds of bidding, 32 valid seaplane routes have been awarded, connecting 25 water aerodromes in the States/UTs of Gujarat, Assam, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Goa, Himachal Pradesh, and Lakshadweep for seaplane operations. Under UDAN 5.5 Letters of Intent (LoI) have been issued to the airline operators for bids connecting the water-bodies in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Kerala and the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar islands.

(b) to (d): Currently, there are no operational seaplane routes.
