

Reporting of Occurrences

The legal responsibility for notification of an accident rests first with the commander of the aircraft or, if he be killed or incapacitated, then the operator.

If the accident occurs on or adjacent to an aerodrome, then the aerodrome authority is also required to notify the accident.

The notification is required to be passed with the following information:

Details to be Provided	Details
Notify the Occurrence "ACCID" in case of an accident or, in the case of a serious incident, "INCID";	
Type, Model, Nationality and Registration marks of the aircraft	
Names of the owner, operator and hirer (if any) of the aircraft	
Date and Time (UTC) of the accident	
Last point of departure	
Point of Intended Landing	
Geographical Coordinates of the Place of Occurrence	
Injuries To Person	
Fatalities	
Damage to the Aircraft	
Carriage of Dangerous Good. Description, if carried	
Brief Description of Accident
