

The Screening committee has approved the proposals for acquisition of Acs. 168.25 Gts in Nakkapally Village, Hanmakonda Mandal vide Resolution dt.31.08.2013. In the year 2012 an amount of Rs 1.00 crore was released.

The District Collector, Warangal has furnished revised estimates for an amount of Rs. 58.60 crores (Rs.59.60 crores – Rs.1.00 crore) towards land acquisition at Warangal District, due to increase in land value from Rs. 4.00 lakhs to Rs. 6.00 lakhs per acre from 2009 – 2014 under the new land acquisition policy. The proposal is under examination of the Government.
