JITHENDER REDDY, MP (LOK SABHA)	<p><u>NOTE ON AIRPORTS IN TELANGANA STATE</u></p> <p>During a National level meeting on Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) convened by the Hon'ble Union Minister for Civil Aviation with the Ministers of Civil Aviation and Tourism and C.S / Senior Officers of the State Government on 29th July, 2016 at New Delhi, the Hon'ble Minister for MA&UD, I&C has submitted the following comments/ suggestions of the State Government, on the RCS vide D.O Lr. Dt 29.07.2016.</p> <p>The State Government in a reference dated 29.07.2016 have confirmed the following to Government of India.</p> <p>Reduction of VAT to 1% on ATF at RCS Airports for 10 years.</p> <p>Providing minimum land, wherever required free of cost and arrange for multi-modal hinterland connectivity.</p>	<p>Government of Telangana on 11.1.2017 has signed the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) on RCS- UDAN with the Ministry of Civil Aviation for providing concessions required from State Government as envisaged in the Scheme. Airline operator will apply for operation from various airports on the basis of their assessment for commercial viability of operations. Revival of these airstrips and airports will be demand driven depending on firm demand from airlines operator.</p> <p>2. RCS is a demand driven scheme. The Technical bids for RCS routes have been opened and the evaluation process is in progress. The selection of the airport will be based on the awarded routes. However, it is intimated that no bids have been received for the airports at Warangal, Adilabad, Basant Nagar in Karimnagar Dist., Dundigal, Hakimpet and Nadirgul in Hyderabad, Nagarjuna Sagar, Nalgonda, Aleru and Kagaznagar (Sirpur).</p>

State Government was requested to furnish copies of Techno Economic Feasibility Report (TEFR)/ Detailed Project Report (DPR) along with the application for seeking 'in principle' approval via letter dated October, 2016 is awaited .</p> <p>A feasibility study of Jakranpally Airport was undertaken on 05.06.2013 by AAI. As per the report, an airport is feasible at the proposed site with ample scope for future expansion. However, the air space of the site is restricted and is in the control of IAF and therefore deliberation with IAF is required for availability of air space for civil use and an Obstacle Limitation Surface Survey is also required to be undertaken before taking up the final decision.</p>

As per the MoU, the State Government shall acquire additional land required for the development of airport and transfer the same to Airports Authority of India for free of cost and free from all encumbrances.

This is an existing airport in an area of 748.02 acres. The AAI has requested for an additional land of 438 acres for development of the airport. The Airports Authority of India have informed that they have demarcated certain lands and fixed boundary stones on the spot for taking up of new terminal building, extension of runway and isolation bay of Warangal Airfield.

There is no Government land available nearby existing airport, certain patta lands have been identified for the development of Warangal Airport. The Airports Authority of India with the assistance of the Assistant Director, Survey and Land Records, Warangal has surveyed the lands for construction of airport.

On request of the State Government, the AAI

process by the State Govt. AAI will start the development work after handing over the land by the State Govt. (AAI)

agreed to take up the development of Warangal Airport and the development works can be taken up only after land is handed over to AAI. The land acquisition process has been initiated and the same is under progress.

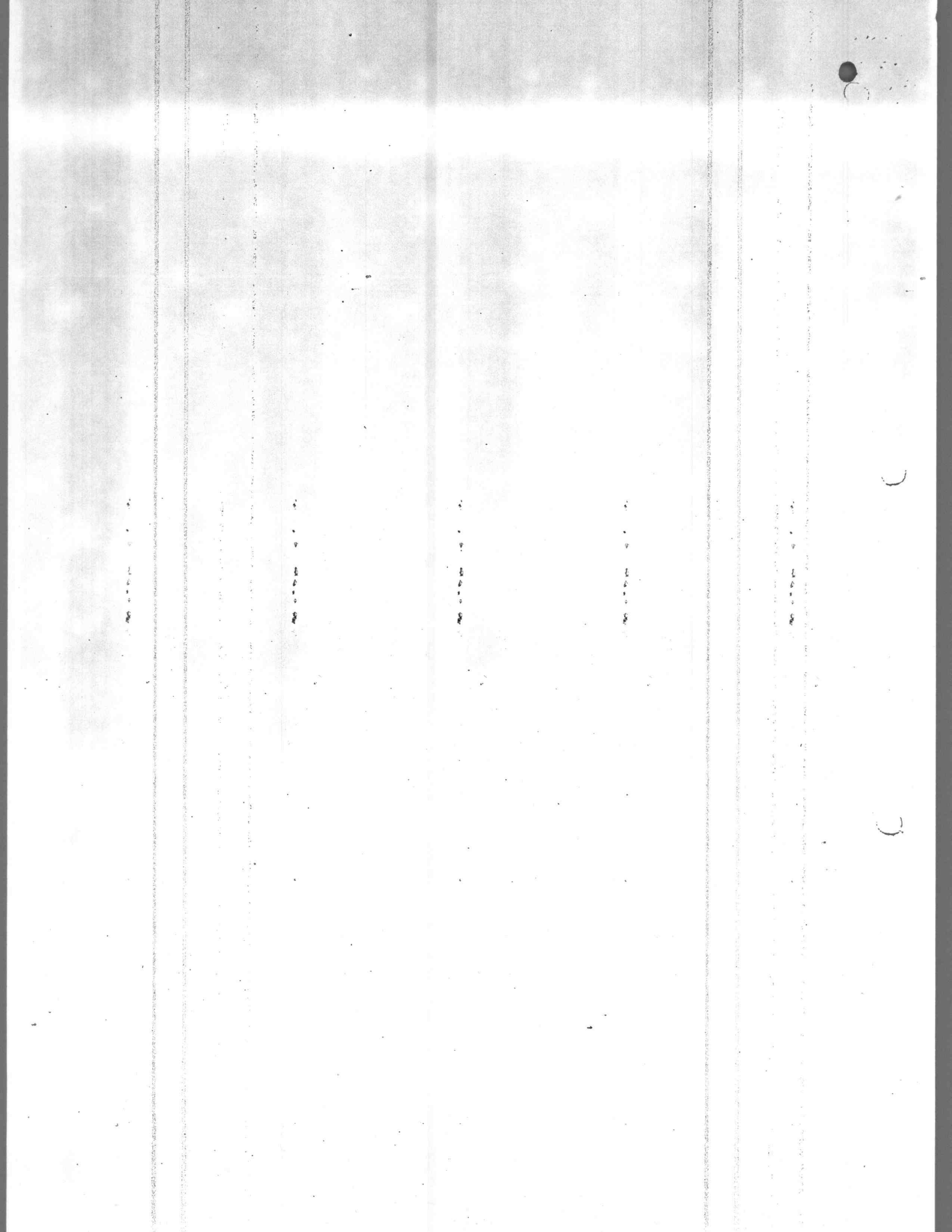
The LAO/ RDO, Warangal has initiated the L.A. case and submitted Draft Notification U/s 4 (1) of the L.A. Act to an extent of Acs. 168.25 Gts. of Patta land. The Screening committee has approved the proposals for acquisition of Acs. 168.25 Gts in Nakkapally Village, Hanmakonda Mandal vide Resolution dt.31.08.2013. In the year 2012 an amount of Rs 1.00 crore was released.

The District Collector, Warangal has furnished revised estimates for an amount of Rs. 58.60 crores (Rs.59.60 crores – Rs.1.00 crore) towards land acquisition at Warangal District, due to increase in land value from Rs. 4.00 lakhs to Rs. 6.00 lakhs per acre from 2009 – 2014 under the new land acquisition policy. The proposal is under examination of the Government.
