### Detailed Monthly information for the month of August, 2023

Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

#### MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION

- 1. An MoU was signed between Government of New Zealand and Government of India relating to Air Services. India now has an open sky arrangement with New Zealand.
- 2. The Ministry of Civil Aviation granted permission for operation of charter flights from Afghanistan and United Arab Emirates under special circumstances.
- 3. One new Airport at Utkela in Odisha and four new routes commenced under Regional Connectivity Scheme in the month of August, 2023.
- 4. AAI Cargo Logistics and Allied Services Company Limited (AAICLAS) commissioned newly built domestic air cargo facility with Regulated Agent (RA) operations at Pune Airport on 05.08.2023.
- 5. Four hundred and thirty eight drones were registered and Unique Identification Number (UIN) were issued.
- 6. Seven hundred and thirty five Remote Pilot certificates were issued.
- 7. Three new Remote Pilot Training Organisations (RPTO) commenced.
- 8. National Air Sports Guidelines 2023 published on 31.08.2023.
