Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION

- 1. Approval of the Cabinet has been obtained for the following proposals:
 - (i) Signing of Air Services Agreement between the Governments of Republic of India and Co-operative Republic of Guyana and
 - (ii) Ratification of three Protocols on Article 3 bis, Article 50(a) & Article 56 relating to amendments in the Convention on International Civil Aviation (Chicago Convention), 1944.
- 2. Bilateral meeting with Omani Delegation to discuss air services matters between both the countries was held on 28th February, 2023.
- 3. The Ministry of Civil Aviation granted permission for operation of charter flights from Afghanistan and Iraq under special circumstances.

During February, 2023, ACI-ASQ survey at 15 AAI airports was conducted successfully.

COMMISSION OF RAILWAY SAFETY (CRS)

- A. 30 statutory inspections of Network Expansion related work of Doubling / Multiple Lines / New Lines / Gauge Conversion for a length of 471.88kms were done by the Commissioners and authorizations issued, thus making the cumulative total of these works during the year 2022-23 to 2972.28kms.
