## Detailed Monthly Report for the month of January, 2024

1. Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

### **MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION**

- 1. Wings India 2024, a biennial international aviation event, was organised from 18th to 21st January 2024 at Begumpet Airport, Hyderabad with the theme of "Connecting India to the World in Amrit Kaal: Setting the Stage for Indian Civil Aviation @2047"
- 2. Passengers carried by domestic airlines during January- December 2023 were 1520.32 lakh as against 1232.45 lakh during the corresponding period of the previous year thereby registering annual growth of 23.36%.
- 3. Ayodhya Airport was declared as International Airport and renamed as "Maharishi Valmiki International Airport, Ayodhya Dham.
- 4. New integrated terminal building at Trichy Airport in Tamil Nadu was inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister.
- 5. Commencement of new RCS airports and routes: Two (02) routes have been commenced in the month of January 2024.
- 6. Airports Authority of India has awarded work contract for development of new greenfield airport at Dholera, Ahmedabad (Phase 1)
- 7. The new Aerodrome license of the Chitrakoot Airport was issued by DGCA.
- 8. International air cargo operations at Bhubaneswar Airport has been commenced on 31-01-2024 with the Financial Support from State Government of Odisha.
- 9. An interim international air cargo terminal operationalized at Pune airport has been inaugurated on 10-01-2024.
- 10. ATC Tower cum technical Block and other associated works at Raja Bhoj Airport, Bhopal.
- 11. Promotions of drone were continued and following achievements were made in previous month:
  - a) 1039 Unique Identification Number (UIN) were issued in the month of January 2024.
  - b) 200 Remote Pilot Certificates (RPC) were issued in the month of January 2024
  - c) Two new Type Certificate issued during the month of January 2024.
  - d) One new Remote Pilot Training Organisation viz., Drone Guru India Technologies Private Limited has been approved by DGCA during the month of January 2024.

#### DIRECTORATE GENERAL OF CIVIL AVIATION (DGCA)

- A. The following Civil Aviation Requirement (CAR) in important area has been revised by DGCA during the month of January, 2024:
  - CAR M issue 02 Rev 06 dated 01<sup>st</sup> January 2024 includes provisions for Electronic Log Book.

ii. CAR 7/J/III:-Duty Period, Flight Duty Period, Flight Time Limitations and Prescribed Rest Periods — Flight crew Engaged in Scheduled Air Transport Operations Issue III Rev I was revised to mitigate fatigue and introduce measures to provide adequate rest between flights.

Salient Points

Definition of Night Duty Changed to 0000hrs-0600hrs and includes WOCL, Positioning to included any means of transportation and Bunk, Isolated Rest and Basic Rest Seats added. Ultra Long Range (ULR) definition modified.

Operations approaching Night Duty restricted max flight time (FT) of 8 hrs & Flight Duty Period (FDP) to 10 hrs with 02 landings.

Max Duty Period now restricted to FDP plus 1 hour.

Weekly Rest increased to 48hrs including 02 local Nights.

Augmented Crew Operations Flight Time and FDP for 03 and 04 crew modified.

Minimum rest period of 10 hrs (from 0000hrs) shall be given to flight crew on returns to duty after leave.

Not more than two consecutive nights duty, except once within a period of 168 hours.

The rest period shall be increased by 24 hours after 02 consecutive ULR flights.

In case of unforeseen circumstance, maximum flight time and Flight Duty Period can be extended by 1 /2 hours respectively which is required to be recorded and reported to DGCA by Head of Operations on quarterly basis.

iii. **CAR 8/S/VIII**: Specific Approval for Operational Use of Electronic Flight Bag (EFB) Issue I Rev I.

Introduction of Cabin Electronic Flight Bag (C-EFB), Electronic journey log book, technical log/flight log (E-JLB) and Less Paper Cockpit (LPC).

Introduction of Training programs for non aircrew using similar devices and applications and are interacting with flight crew members. Examples are maintenance personnel, loading personnel, and dispatchers. Training must emphasize the coordinated procedures with flight crew members.

The modifications to EFB Hardware/Software and/or OS which are Minor upgrades, or do not introduce any additional functionality to an existing EFB function may be introduced by the operator without the need to notify the competent authority, as long as a comprehensive risk assessment has been carried out.
