Observance of Vigilance Awareness Week-2023

- Vigilance Awareness Week was observed from 30th October to 5th November 2023
 with the theme "Say No to Corruption, Commit to the Nation" in the main Ministry
 as well as attached/Subordinate offices, Autonomous Bodies and Public Sector
 Undertakings under this Ministry.
- It commenced with the 'Integrity pledge' administered by the Secretary, Civil Aviation on 30.10.2022 at 11:00 am to the officers/officials of Ministry of Civil Aviation.
- For wider participation as well as for increasing public awareness, a link for E-pledge (which was available on CVC website) was provided on the Ministry's website.
- An e-mail was also circulated to all the officers and staff of the Ministry encouraging them to take E-pledge (Annex-G). As a result, a large number of employees took the E-pledge, got the Certificate from CVC's website and also provided the copies of the Certificates to Vigilance Division.
