Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month

MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION

1. Passengers carried by domestic airlines continued to grow and was 661.42 lakh during January-May 2024 as against 636.07 lakh during the corresponding period of the previous year, thereby registering annual growth of 3.99%.
2. Under RCS-UDAN, twelve new routes commenced during the month. A total of 579 routes have been operationalized under RCS-UDAN so far.
3. The 7th U.S.-India Aviation Summit was held from 24-26 June, 2024 at Washington D.C. in the United States of America. Indian delegation headed by Secretary (CA) attended the event which witnessed more than 250 senior government officials and private-sector leaders from the United States, India, and South Asia to advance civil aviation cooperation. The Summit was held in cooperation with the Government of India and the U.S.-India Aviation Cooperation Program, and in partnership with the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Aviation Administration and Transportation Security Administration. The event fostered dialogue, built civil aviation partnerships, and showcased advanced U.S. innovations and best practices to further priority aviation and airport projects in India and South Asia. The program included wide-ranging discussions on the future of aviation and growth in the aviation sector.
4. The Union Cabinet on 19th June 2024 approved the proposal of the Ministry of Civil Aviation regarding development of Lal Bahadur Shastri International Airport, Varanasi at an estimated cost of Rs. 2869.65 crore
5. Promotion of drones was continued with following achievements:
 - a. 650 Unique Identification Number (UIN) were issued in the month of June 2024.
 - b. 224 Remote Pilot Certificates (RPC) were issued in the month of June 2024.
 - c. 03 new Type Certificate issued during the month of June 2024.
 - d. 02 new Remote Pilot Training Organisation (RPTO) [Centurion School of Rural Enterprise Management Trust and Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati (IIT-G)] started during the month of June 2024.
