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Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month

MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION

- 1. Passengers carried by domestic airlines continued to grow and was 1054.66 lakh during January-August 2024 as against 1006.16 lakh during the corresponding period of the previous year, thereby registering annual growth of 5.70%.
- 2. Honorable Prime Minister of India inaugurated the new terminal building at Sholapur Airport on September 29, 2024. The new terminal, expanded at an estimated cost of Rs 64.95 crore, is now spread over 1152 square metres, with a capacity to handle 150 passengers during peak hours and has an annual capacity to handle 4.1 lakh passengers.
- 3. The 2nd Asia Pacific Ministerial Conference on Civil Aviation was organized by Ministry of Civil Aviation, Government of India in collaboration with the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) from 11th to 12th September 2024 in Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi. The Conference was attended by Hon'ble Ministers / High level dignitaries from 29 countries including India along with representatives from council member states of ICAO and 10 international organisations.
- 4. A significant milestone of the conference has been the formal adoption of the Delhi Declaration, aimed at enhancing regional cooperation, addressing emerging challenges, and fostering sustainable growth within the civil aviation sector of the Asia Pacific nations.
- 5. Digi Yatra launched by Hon'ble Minister of Civil Aviation on 06.09.2024 at nine airports i.e., Bagdogra, Bhubaneswar, Chandigarh, Coimbatore, Indore, Patna, Raipur, Ranchi and Vishakhapatnam.
- 6. MoCA granted permission for operation of charter flights from Afghanistan and Lebanon under special circumstances during the month of September, 2024.
- 7. Promotion of drones was continued with following achievements:
 - a) 1099 Unique Identification Number (UIN) for drones were issued in the month of September 2024.
 - b) 400 Remote Pilot Certificates (RPC) were issued in the month of September 2024.
 - c) 03 new Type Certificate for drones were issued during the month of September 2024.
 - d) 06 new Remote Pilot Training Organisation were certified by DGCA during the month of September 2024.
