GOVERNMENT OF INDIA MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION MONTHLY SUMMARY FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL, 2015

1. Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

Passenger carried by domestic airlines during January-March, 2015 were <u>185.46 lakhs</u> as against <u>153.81 lakhs</u> during the corresponding period of previous year thereby registering a growth of 20.57 %.

(v) Commission of Railway Safety (CRS):

- (A) No serious train accident occurred during the month of <u>April, 2015</u>.
- **(B)** Statutory inspections were conducted before opening of <u>Five (05)</u> lines for public carriage of passengers.
- (c) During the month of **April**, **2015**, there were <u>Four (04)</u> Periodical or other Inspections of Railway made by the Commission of Railway Safety.

(vi) Ministry (Main):

E-Office - Implementation of 'e-Office', a digital filing system was started in the Ministry in October, 2014 and is nearing completion. The system was officially launched on 25.12.2014 by the Hon'ble Minister for Civil Aviation, as a Good Governance initiative. All new files are being generated through 'e-Office' and digitization of current and closed files are nearing completion. Apart from the Ministry, all subordinate organizations such as DGCA, Air India, Airports Authority of India, Commission of Railway Safety and Pawan Hans Ltd. are also implementing 'e-Office'. The digitized filing system reduces the processing time substantially and ensures transparency and accountability, as any file can be located and dealt with within a few minutes. The service records of the officers and staff are also being digitized, to speed up processing of all personnel claims. The process of E-Service Book in respect of all Officers/Officials in Ministry (Main) has also been started. The Officers/Officials will be able to view their details and apply on-line for grant of leave etc.
