GOVERNMENT OF INDIA MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION MONTHLY SUMMARY FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER, 2015

1. Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

Passengers carried by domestic airlines during January-November, 2015 were <u>733.82 lakhs</u> as against <u>609.43 lakhs</u> during the corresponding period of previous year thereby registering a growth of 20.41%.

Consultation with various stakeholders has been carried out during the month on Draft National Civil Aviation Policy, released on 30th October 2015, including Consultative Committee of Ministry of Civil Aviation. The objective of the Draft Civil Aviation Policy is to create a conducive environment for safe, secure and affordable air travel and for enhancing regional connectivity. It also aims to provide ease of doing business while promoting entire aviation sector chain from Cargo, general aviation, aerospace manufacturing to skill development ensuring overall growth in aviation sector.

- (i) The national Aeronautical Search and Rescue Manual has been circulated to all the concerned Ministries/Deptt..and states/UTs for its implementations.
- (ii) Proposal for exchange of AAI's land measuring 11.45 acres at Visakhapatnam Airport with an equivalent area of land officered by Visakhapatnam Port Trust for setting up of Multi Modal Logistic Park (MMLP) by Ms Container Corporation of India (CONCOR) at Visakhapatnam has been approved by the Cabinet.
