7. Commission of Railway Safety (CRS).

(a) During the month of February, 2017, statutory inquiry was taken up for one unusual incident of involving a passenger train. The detail is as follows:

(i) Unusual incident of death of 03 passenger of UP EMU 40518 Chengalpattu Jn. – Chennai Beach, due to entanglement of passenger bag with signal post of Down starter no.33 at St. Thomas Mount station in Chennai Division of Southern Railway at about 08.55 hrs on 23.02.2017. The Statutory Inquiry was conducted by CRS, Southern Circle on 01.03.2017.

(b) Statutory inspections were conducted before opening of Seventeen (17) lines for public carriage of passengers.

(c) During the month of February, 2017, there were Twelve (12) Periodical or other Inspections of Railways made by the Commissioner of Railway Safety.
