 - iii. To identify projects and report to EGoS
 - iv. To maintain active contact with investors and work with the States, duly adopting ways of onboarding the States to make them a part of the institutional set-up
 - v. To identify policy and regulatory issue that come in the way of investments
 - vi. To engage with potential investors to bring the proposals for consideration of EGoS
- vii. To address any other responsibility assigned by EGoS related to the above tasks.
