Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

1. Ministry of Civil Aviation

- (i) Passengers carried by domestic airlines during January-October, 2017 were **954.45 lakhs** as against **813.70 lakhs** during the corresponding period of previous year thereby registering a growth of **17.30%**.
