## Detailed Monthly information for the month of January, 2022

Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

#### 1. MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION

- A. The process of strategic disinvestment of 100% stake of Government of India in Air India along with equity shareholding of Air India in Air India Express Ltd. (AIXL) and Air India Singapore Airport Terminal Services Ltd. (AISATS) completed on 27.01.2022.
- B. PASSENGER GROWTH: Passengers carried by domestic airlines during January-December, 2021 were 838.14 lakhs as against 630.11 lakhs during the corresponding period of previous year thereby registering annual growth of 33.01% and monthly growth of 52.90%.

#### C. Air Cargo related activities -

In January, 2022, Airports Authority of India Cargo Logistics and Allied Services Company Ltd. (AAICLAS) has handled vaccine cargo consignments containing more than 89.52 lakhs vaccine doses through 33 AAICLAS Air Cargo terminals in the Domestic and International Sectors.

## 4. AIRPORTS AUTHORITY OF INDIA (AAI)

#### TRAFFIC TREND:

Monthly Traffic Reporter for the month of December, 2021 has been prepared and uploaded on AAI website. The broad highlights of Traffic Reporter for the month of December, 2021 and (April – December) 2021-22 are as follows: -

#### DECEMBER, 2021

During the month of December, 2021, all Indian airports taken together handled 204.37 thousand aircraft movements (excluding General Aviation Movements), 25.12 million passengers and 275.38 thousand tonnes of freight.

#### (APRIL- DECEMBER) 2021-22

During the period of April – December 2021-22, all Indian airports taken together handled 1266.93 thousand aircraft movements (excluding General Aviation Movements), 131.62 million passengers and 2372.61 thousand tonnes of freight.

During January, 2022, ACI-ASQ Survey at 13 airports was conducted successfully.

#### 5. Air India Ltd.

- A. The winning bid was of M/s Talace Pvt Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of M/s Tata Sons Pvt. Ltd for Rs.18,000 crore as Enterprise Value (EV) consideration for AI (100% shares of AI along with AI's shareholding in AIXL and AISATS). M/s Talace Pvt Ltd deposited the cash component of Rs. 2,700 crore (15% of Rs. 18,000 crore) in the account of Department of Investment and Public Asset Management (DIPAM) and took over the debt of Rs. 15,300 crore (85% of Rs. 18,000 crore).
- B. The payment of excess debt of Air India was done through the financial support amounting to Rs. 62,057 crore provided by D/o Economic Affairs for settling guaranteed/other past dues/overdues of Air India.

#### 6. Commission of Railway Safety
