Detailed Monthly information for the month of April, 2019

Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

1. Ministry of Civil Aviation

- A. Passengers carried by domestic airlines during Jan, 2019 were 354.53 lakhs as against 337.90 lakhs during the corresponding period of previous year thereby registering a growth of 4.92%
- B. In coordination with CBIC, D/o Revenue, the policy for re-export of aircraft upon termination or expiry of the period of the lease of the aircraft was reviewed. Through a simplified procedure, the lessor of the aircraft would now be able to enter into a new lease agreement with another domestic scheduled airline operator, without first re-exporting the aircraft and then re-importing of the same by the new lessee. In April, 16 aircraft have thus been re-leased within India after a number of aircraft were deregistered by DGCA following the invocation of Cape Town Convention provisions by the IDERA Holders of these aircraft.

D. TRAFFIC TREND:

MARCH, 2019 VIS-À-VIS MARCH, 2018

The aircraft movements and passenger traffic have decreased by -0.1 percent and -1.1 percent respectively while the freight traffic has increased by 2.0 percent at all Indian airports taken together during March, 2019 over March, 2018.

(APRIL- MARCH) 2018-19 VIS-A-VIS (APRIL- MARCH) 2017-18

Aircraft Movements: The international and domestic aircraft movements have witnessed an increase of 3.4 percent and 14.1 percent respectively resulting into 12.1 percent increase in total aircraft movements during (April – March) 2018-19 as compared to (April-March) 2017-18.

Passengers: The international and domestic passengers traffic have shown an increase of 6.1 percent and 13.1 percent respectively resulting into overall increase of 11.6 percent in total passenger traffic during the period (April- March) 2018-19 as compared to (April- March) 2017-18.

Freight: The international and domestic freight traffic have shown growth of 2.6 percent and 12.1 percent respectively resulting into overall increase of 6.0 percent in total freight traffic during the period (April-March) 2018-19 as compared to (April-March) 2017-18.

- E. The result for ACI ASQ Survey Q1 (January-March) 2019 has been published on time and the results for the first time published in bilingual format. Out of 24 AAI airports, 22 have achieved score above the world average of 4.25. The average of 24 AAI airports is 4.60.
- F. 20 Airports namely Allahabad, Aurangabad, Belgaum, Bhuj, Dibrugarh, Dimapur, Gaya, Gorakhpur, Jabalpur, Jamnagar, Jodhpur, Jorhat, Kangra, Khajuraho, Leh, Rajahmundry, Rajkot, Silchar, Surat and Tuticorin have been selected by AAI to be declared as single use plastic free terminal by 15th Sept. 2019.
