Monthly Traffic Reporter for the month of December, 2019 has been prepared and uploaded on AAI website. The broad highlights of Traffic Reporter for the month of December, 2019 and (April - Dec) 2019-20 are as follows: -

DECEMBER, 2019 VIS-À-VIS DECEMBER, 2018

During the month of December 2019, all Indian airports taken together handled 234.55 thousand aircraft movements (excluding General Aviation Movements), 31.85 million passengers and 282.73 thousand tonnes of freight. The aircraft movements and passenger traffic have increased by 2.3% and 1.9% respectively while the freight has decreased by 4.2% during December, 2019 over December, 2018

(APRIL- DECEMBER) 2019-20 VIS-À-VIS (APRIL - DECEMBER) 2018-19

During the period of (April-December) 2019-20, all Indian airports taken together handled 1964.86 thousand aircraft movements (excluding General Aviation Movements), 262.68 million passengers and 2572.71 thousand tonnes of freight. The aircraft movements and passenger traffic have increased by 0.1% and 1.8% respectively while the freight has decreased by 4.8% during the period under study.

E. Open Access Aviation Fuel Facility (AFF) at Bhubaneswar Airport

In principal approval for this pilot project at Bhubaneswar Airport accorded on nomination basis to M/s Indian Oil Sky tanking Pvt. Ltd. The Draft

Concession Agreement, DPR & Financial Model submitted by M/s IOSL examined by the committee and recommended for consideration of the pilot project. As per the recommendation of the duly constituted committee a consultant is being appointed for finalizing the Concession and Operating Agreement for AFF at Bhubaneswar Airport and also to provide transaction advisory services for creation of open access AFF at 04 (Chennai, Kolkata and other Airports) more Airports of AAI. Accordingly, consultancy work is awarded to M/s Ernst & Young LLP on 17th Jan. 2020.
