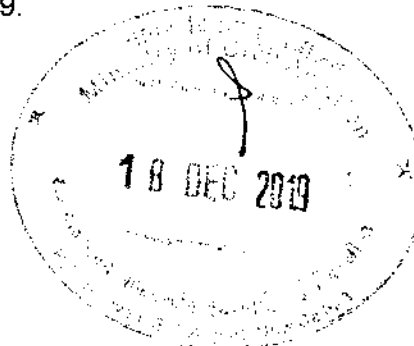

#### D. TRAFFIC TREND:

Monthly Traffic Reporter for the month of October, 2019 has been prepared and uploaded on AAI website. The broad highlights of Traffic Reporter for the month of October, 2019 and (April- Oct) 2019-20 are as follows:

##### OCTOBER, 2019 VIS-À-VIS OCTOBER, 2018

During the month of October 2019, all Indian airports taken together handled 230.92 thousand aircraft movements (excluding General Aviation Movements), 29.58 million passengers and 300.39 thousand tonnes of freight. The aircraft movements and passenger traffic have increased by 2.0% and 2.9% respectively while the freight has decreased by 6.5% during October, 2019 over October, 2018.

##### APRIL- OCTOBER) 2019-20 VIS-À-VIS (APRIL- OCTOBER) 2018-19

During the period of (April-October) 2019-20, all Indian airports taken together handled 1502.38 thousand aircraft movements (excluding General Aviation Movements), 199.61 million passengers and 2010.61 thousand tonnes of freight. The passenger traffic has increased by 0.7% while aircraft movements and freight traffic have decreased by 0.7% and 5.0% respectively during the period under study.
