## GOVERNMENT OF INDIA MINISTRY OF CIVIL AVIATION MONTHLY SUMMARY FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 2015

1. Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

Passenger carried by domestic airlines during January-September, 2015 were <u>590.21 lakhs</u> as against <u>491.44 lakhs</u> during the corresponding period of previous year thereby registering a **growth of 20.10 %.** 

- (i) Draft National Civil Aviation Policy has been released by Minister of Civil Aviation on 30<sup>th</sup> October 2015 and the same has been put on website for inviting comments of all Stakeholders. The mission of the Draft Civil Aviation Policy is to provide safe, secure, affordable and maintainable air travel with access to various parts of India and world with an objective of enhanced regional connectivity, ease of doing business and promote entire aviation sector chain from Cargo, general aviation, aerospace manufacturing to skill development.
- (ii) The Ministry of Civil Aviation (Height Restriction for safeguarding of Aircraft Operations) Rules 2015 [G.S.R. 751 dated 30.9.2015] have been notified in Gazette of India on 01.10.2015.
- (iii) Surrender of 12 acres of land back to State Govt. of Karnataka out of 600 acres of land handed over by State Govt. to AAI at Hubli Aiirport has been approved by the Cabinet in its meeting held on 07.10.2015.
- (iv) Common User Domestic Cargo Terminal (CUDT) at Chennai Airport was commissioned on 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2015.
