5. Commission of Railway Safety (CRS).

- **A.** (a) During the month of **November**, **2016**, **two (02)** statutory inquiries have been taken up by Commission of Railway Safety:
 - (i) Derailment of train No.19321 Dn. Indore Rajendra Nagar Patna Express between Pakarayan Malasa at Km.1290/06 on CNB-JHS Division of North Central Railway on 20.11.2016. It is regret to mention that as a result of this accident, 150 Passengers were killed and 180 passengers got injuries, 57 of them grievously Inquiry by CRS, Eastern Circle, Kolkata.
 - (ii) Derailment of train No.54703 Abohar Jodhpur passenger between Rajjasar Arjansar at km.178/4-5 on Bhatinda Bikaner Section of Bikaner Division of North Western Railway on 19.11.2016. As a result of this accident, 05 passengers were injured Inquiry by CRS, Western Circle, Mumbai.
 - (b) Statutory inspections were conducted before opening of **Eight (08)** lines for public carriage of passengers.
 - (c) During the month of **November**, **2016**, there were **Eight (08)** Periodical or other Inspections of Railway made by the Commissioners of Railway Safety.
