ORDER

With a view to streamline the procedure as also for ease of doing business in aviation sector, the Ministry of Civil Aviation has reviewed the existing procedure for import/acquisition of aircrafts / helicopter by Air operators and has decided to delegate its power for grant of 'In-principle' approval for import/acquisition of the aircraft/helicopter to DGCA. Henceforth, Ministry of Civil Aviation's approval for obtaining 'In-principle' approval for import/acquisition of aircraft / helicopter would not be required. To that extent, the existing Order dated 25.3.2013 stands modified.

- 2. However, permission for starting new Scheduled and Non-Scheduled Air Transport Services (including Regional Air Transport Services) for granting initial No Objection Certificate (NOC) shall continue to be exercised by the Ministry.
- This issues with the approval of Secretary (Civil Aviation).
